Presidents of Tafila and Irbid governorates councils were determined by acclamation and draw

RASED praises the transparency and coordination of the ministry of interior in managing governorates councils offices elections

Within the framework of monitoring the elected councils, RASED worked on tracking the process selecting and appointing the offices of the governorates councils, which came after the minister of interior call to hold the first meeting for governorates councils on Sunday 8 Sep 2017 at10:00 AM, the monitoring results showed that three women won positions in governorates councils offices, 8.3% of offices positions in Jordan, the elected members took all the seats of governorates councils presidents, and the appointed members took 8.3% of all the positions of councils' offices in Jordan.

The information gathered by RASED team showed the 12 presidents of governorates councils were all males, and 12 Vice Presidents including one women in governorate of Ma'an, and 12 Assistant Presidents including two women in the governorates of Zarqa and Jarash, knowing that the two women are appointed members.

In details, President of governorate council of Irbid won by draw, and the President of Tafila' governorate council by acclamation, while presidency for the remaining 10 governorates councils were determined by polling. The Vice President positions two members were selected acclamation in Mafraq and Aqaba, and one Vice President by draw in Ajloun, the remaining 9 Vice Presidents were selected by polling. One Assistant President were selected by draw in Aqaba, 5 assistants by acclamation in Balqa, Tafila, Karak, Madaba, and Ma'an, while 6 assistants were elected in 6 governorates.

As for the results of the governorates councils' presidency elections, Omar Abdualla Yousef Maqableh won in the governorate of Irbid by draw, and Othman Nayef Al Sawaea for Vice President, and Assistant President for Khaldoun Mohammed Irshod Bani Hani by polling.

In Mafraq Mohammed Khalaf Al Makazi Akho Irshaida was elected as President of the governorate council, Abdulkarim Mohammed Ahmad Al Qadi for Vice President by acclamation, and Ibrahim Odeh Owaed was elected as Assistant President. In Jarash Mahmoud Abdulkarim Issa Afif was elected for the President position, Saleem Hamdan Al Ayasra for Vice President, and Hind Saleh Al Shrouqi for Assistant President by polling also.

For the governorate council of Ajloun, Mohammad Nour Abdulrahman Al Smadi was elected for the President position, Reda Ali Al Momani for Vice President by draw, and Sami Freihat as Assistant President by polling. In Amman Ahmad Marwan Salem Al Abdullat was elected as President for Amman governorate council, Mohannad Al Neamat and Mani Farhan Al Adeinat were elected for the Vice President and Assistant President positions respectively.

In Zarqa Ahmad Ali Hamad Eliemat was elected as President of the governorate council, Salameh Mohammed Salman Al Blowi for Vice President, and Fadwas Jihad Al Shaikh for Assistant President both by polling.

In the governorate of Madaba, Yousef Salem Abdulhadi Al Ghlailat was elected for the President position, Mansour Salameh Hamad Al Hawatmeh was elected for as Vice President, Hamza Al Mawazreh for Assistant President by acclamation.

In the governorate of Balqa, Musa Ahmad Abdullah Awamleh was elected as President of the governorate council by polling, Jamal Abdullah Olayan Zeyadat as Vise President of the governorate council by polling, and Emad Zaidan Abdul Hamid Al-Adwan as Assistant President of the governorate council by acclamation.

In the governorate of Karak, Sa'il Meteb Aref Majali was elected as President of the governorate council by polling, Mahmoud Aref Mohammed al-Ashush as Vise President of the governorate council by polling, and Mujahid Faiq Khalil al-Qurum as Assistant President of the governorate council by acclamation.

In the governorate of Tafileh, Mohammed AbdulAziz Salem Al-Kraimein was elected as President of the governorate council by acclamation, Hani Amarein as Vise President of the governorate council by polling, and Qasem Aqar as Assistant President of the governorate council by acclamation.

In the governorate of Ma'an, AbdulKarim Mohammed Fahad al-Jazi was elected as President of the governorate council by polling, with Ayda Mohamed Abdul Jalil Khattab as Vise President of the governorate council by polling, and Ahmed Al-Rafaiya as Assistant President of the governorate council by acclamation.

In the governorate of Aqaba, Mohammed Ali Eid al-Zawaydeh was elected President of the governorate council by polling, with Ali Mahmoud Khalil al-Helawi as Vise President of the governorate council by acclamation, and Ali Salem Hassan Abu Khalil as Assistant President of the governorate council by draw.

RASED praises the administrative work and efforts made by the Ministry of Interior to elect the offices for the governorate councils in a transparent and professional manner, and for allowing observers to attend these sessions. RASED also recognizes that the Ministry has allowed the public to attend the first meeting of those whom they have elected. RASED will publish the names of all the heads of the standing committees in each governorate council upon the completion of their election process.
