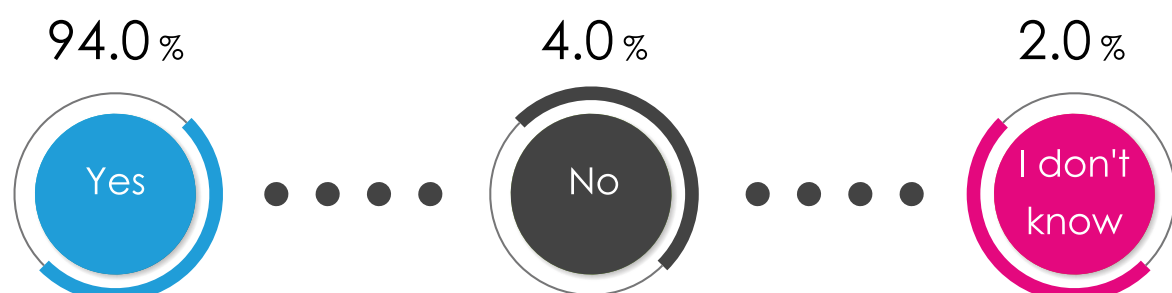
Using the privacy feature for posts, do you allow other than friends to comment on your posts - Facebook?

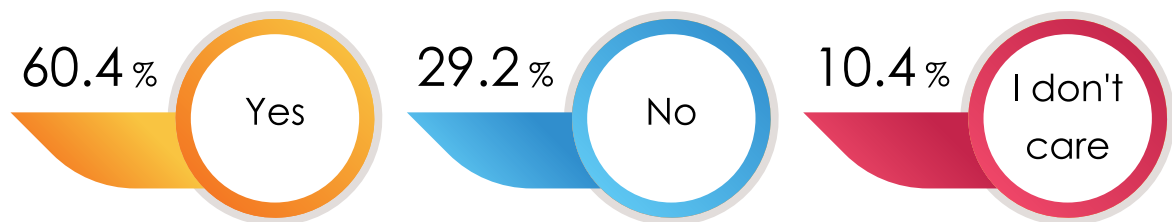

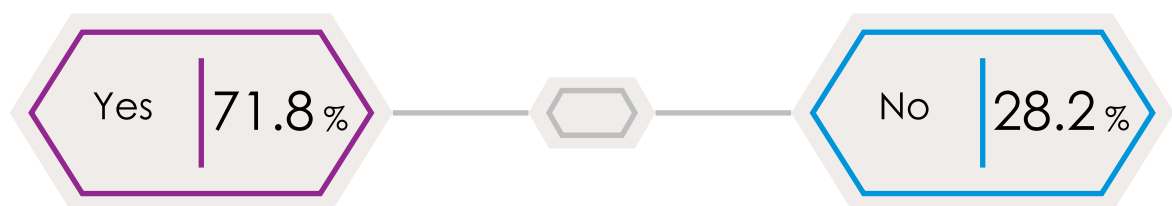

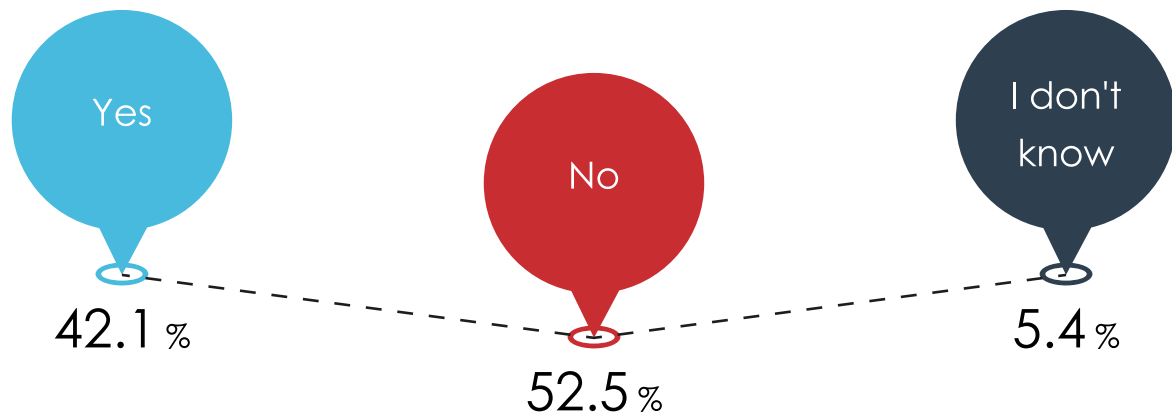

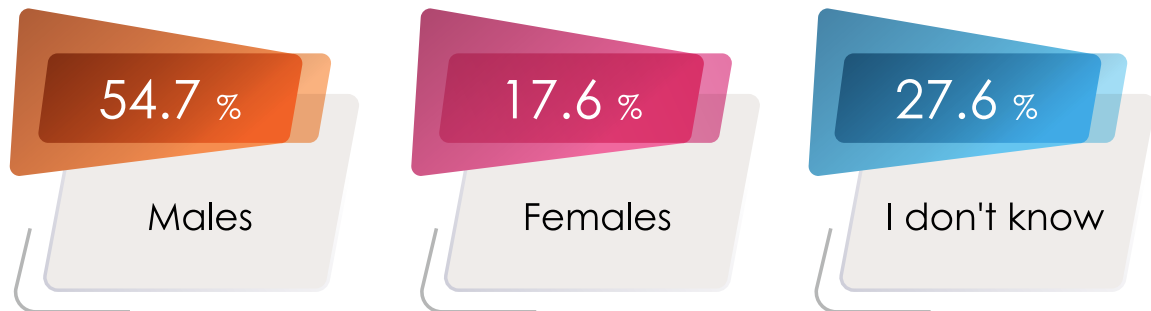

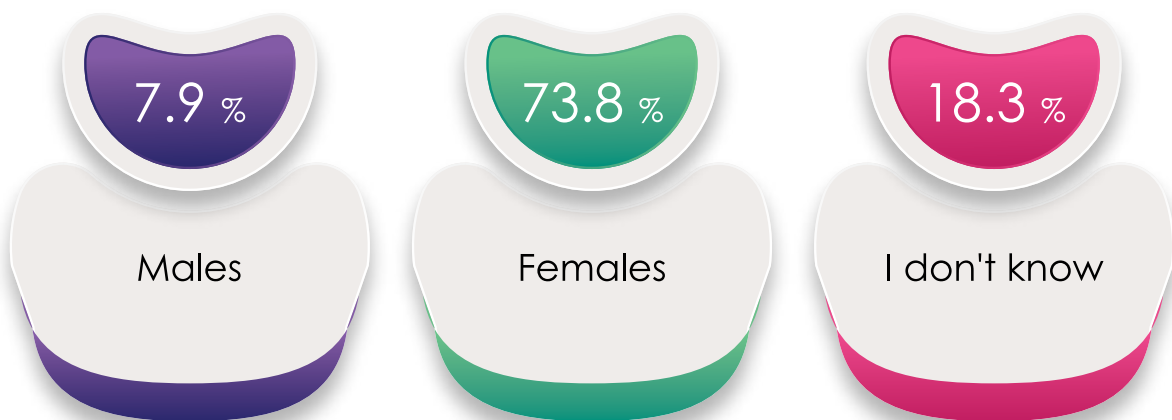

➤ Posting on economic issues (example: sharing economic assessment reports, opinion on economic issue management, raising salaries, price inflation, etc.)	4.9 %
➤ Posting on sports issues (example: supporting a specific club or certain sports phenomenon, etc.)	1.2 %
➤ Personal (example: posts related to my family, social relations, etc.)	11.1 %
➤ Criticism of a person (example: sharing posts that are critical of persons)	12.3 %
➤ Other	12.5 %

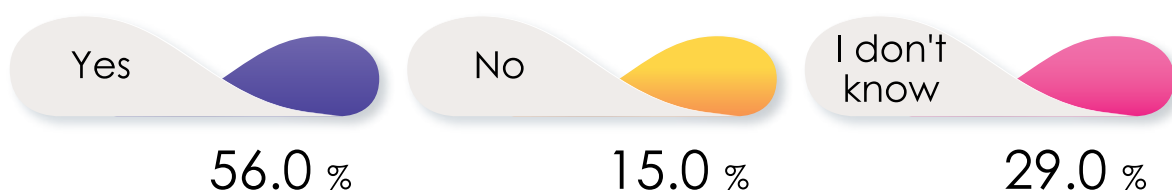

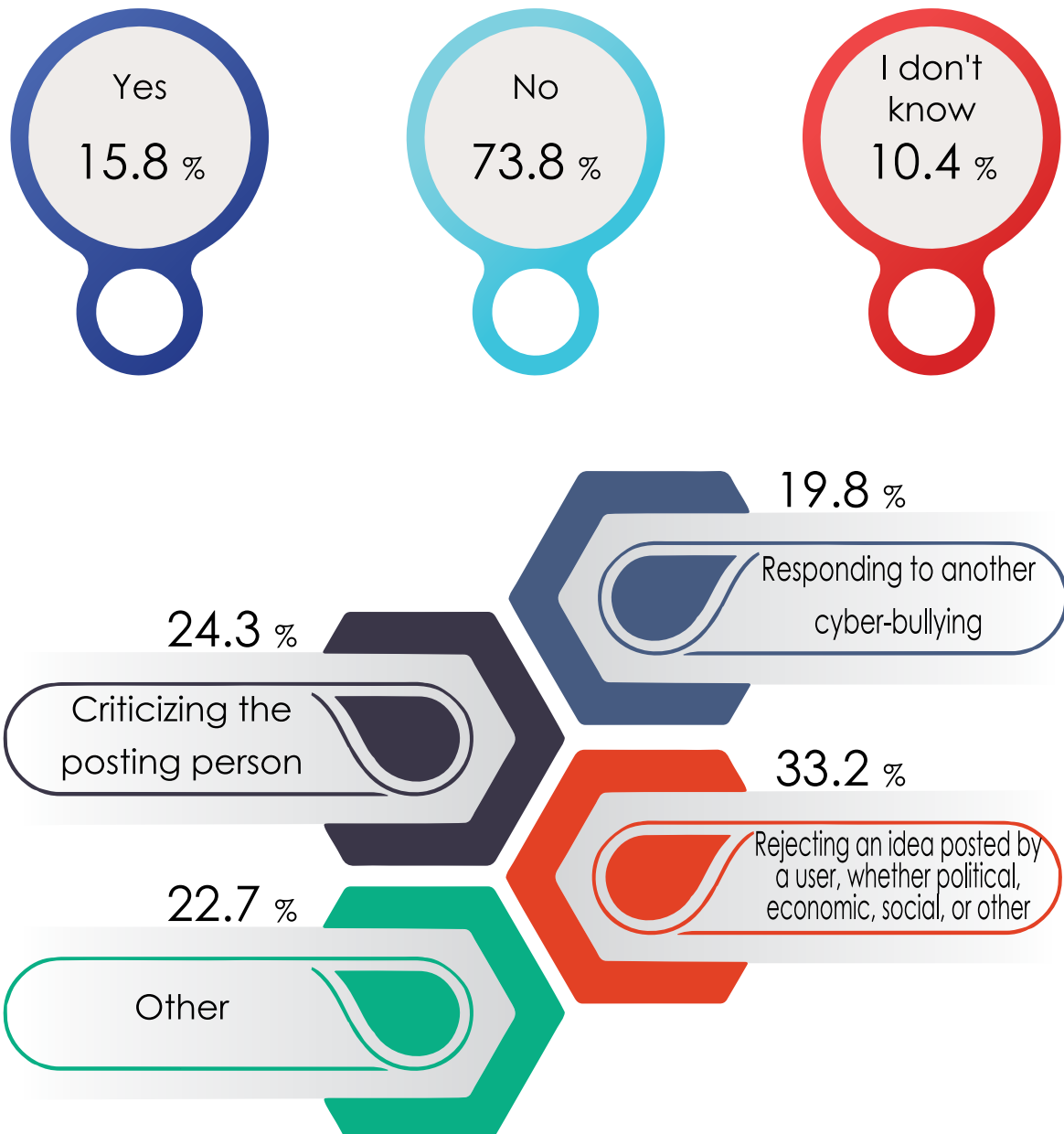
Who do you think suffers from cyber-bullying more?



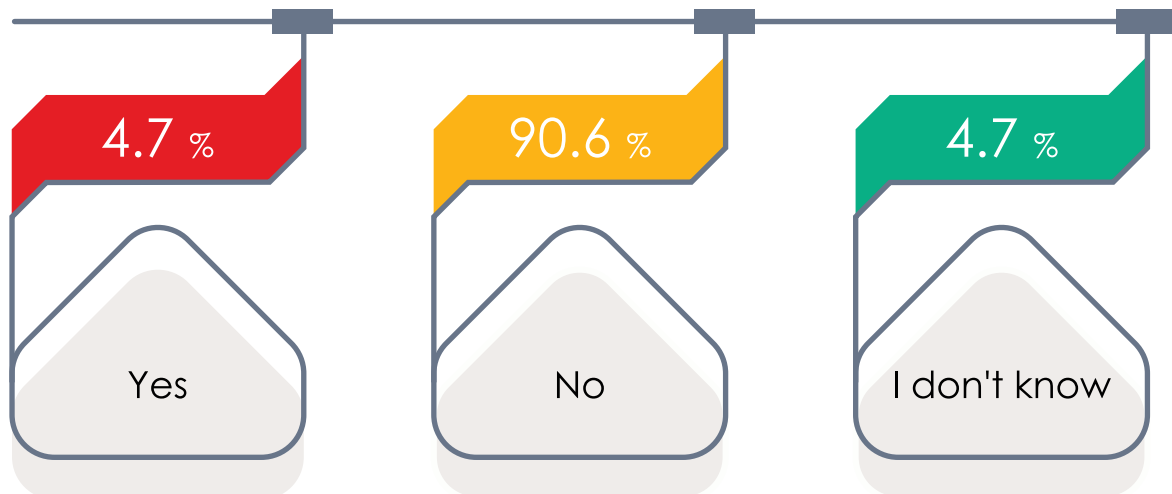
Has any of your friends faced cyber-bullying?



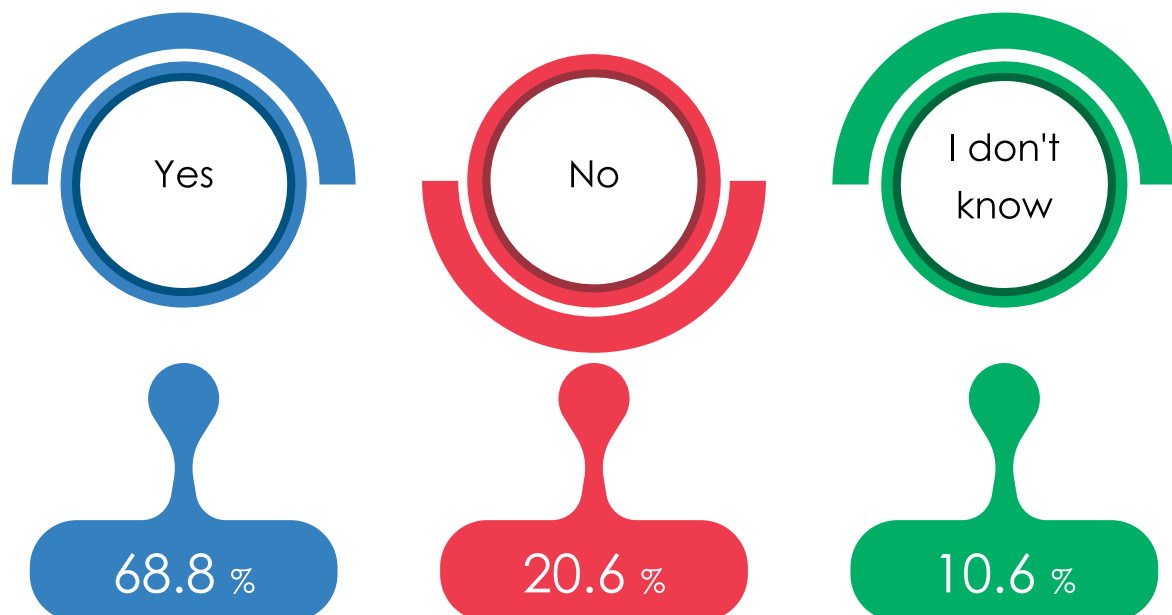

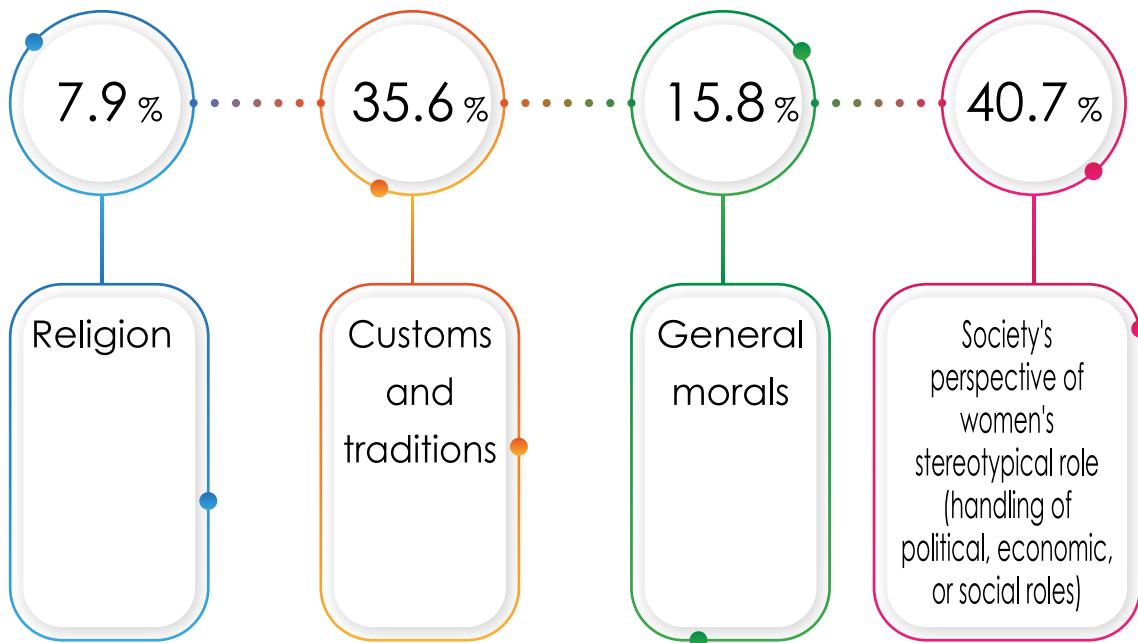

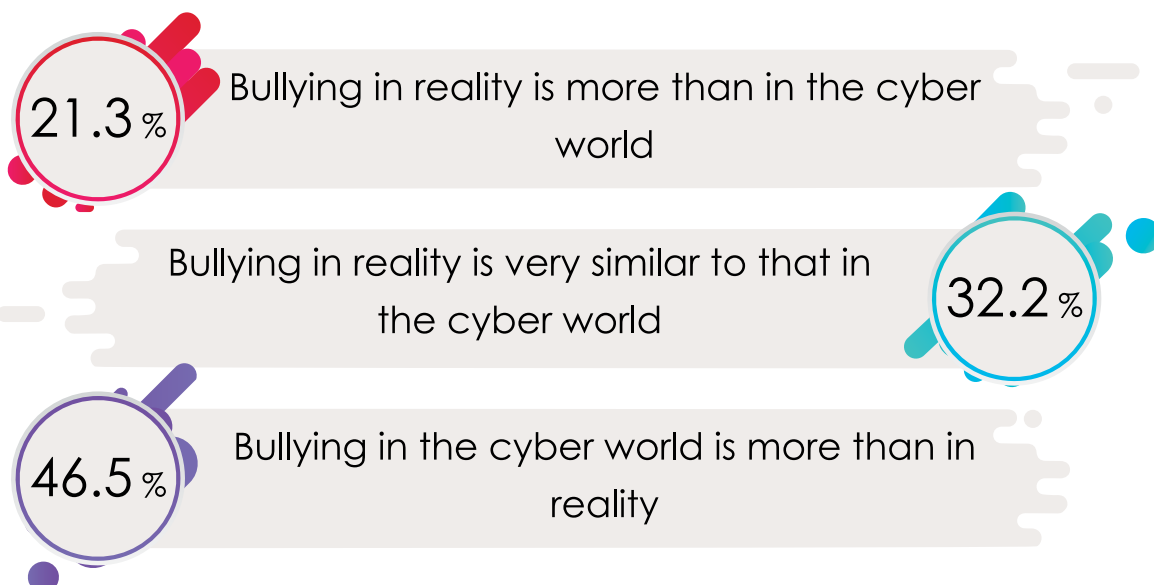

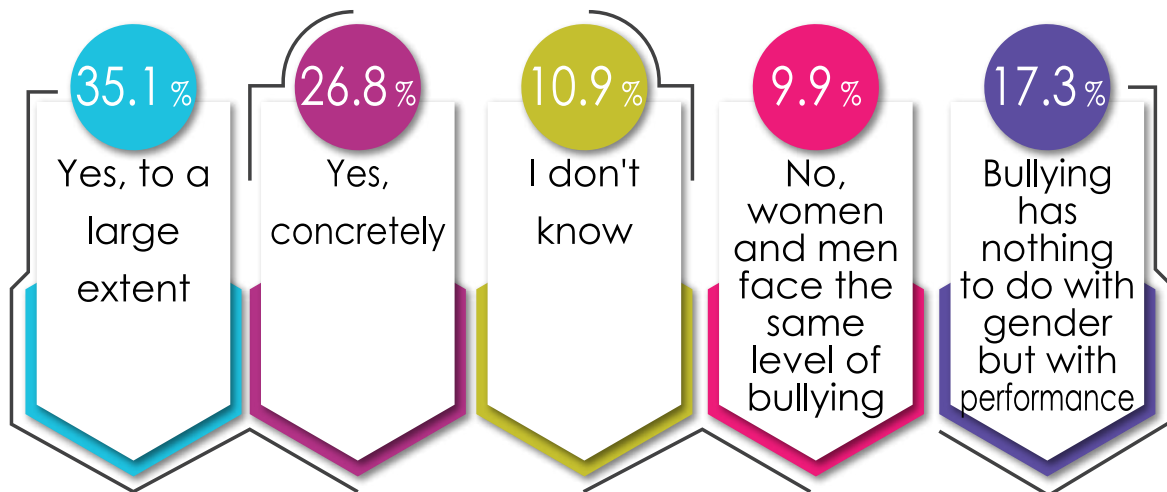
